4. Fighting divisions will be divided by weight.

5. Breaking competitors must purchase boards at the door.

# **Special Events**\*\*\*

### Scoring Criteria

**a.** Difficulty of Technique will be based on the following order of superiority: hand technique standing kick technique, jump kick technique, kicking technique with spinning motion, jump kick with spinning motion, multiple breaking jump kick, multiple spinning jump kick.

- **b.** Difficulty of breaking will also be based on the number of boards
- **c.** Technique will be based on Accuracy, Speed, and Power
- **d.** The maximum time to complete the performance is 1 min
- e. The maximum number of tries is 2 times
